Admission to IWA OutdoorClassics is restricted exclusively to trade visitors. Your trade visitor status must therefore be proved when purchasing your entrance ticket. Children and young people under 18 years of age are not admitted to the exhibition.

Who qualifies as a Trade Visitor at IWA OutdoorClassics? Admissible Sectors of Economy:

- Guns, gun components and machining
- Archery
- Ammunition and reloading
- Optics
- Knives
- Clothing
- Gifts
- General outdoor articles
- Shooting sports accessories
- Hunting accessories
- Equipment for civilian and official self-defense
- Police authorities
- Armed forces
- Bodyguards
- Security services
- Personal security requisites
- Forestry authorities
- Trade information/publishers

The following are not admitted: sports marksman, children and young people under 18 years of age, private visitors, hunters, members of hunting and sports shooting clubs and all persons not employed in the sectors listed above.

What documents are required?

- Business registration document: Which clearly indicate that the company trades in goods exhibited at IWA OutdoorClassics.
- Extract from the commercial register: Which clearly indicate that the company trades in goods exhibited at IWA OutdoorClassics.
- License to sell guns (not a gun license!)
- Recent supplier invoices: which clearly indicate that the company trades in goods exhibited at IWA OutdoorClassics.
- **Service identification card or troop's identity card**: Police officers and Soldiers as well official pass issued by an official agency entitled to admission.
- **Employees**: can prove their eligibility with a written confirmation from their employer; i.e. a confirmation on company paper with letterhead in which the employee is mentioned by name and confirmed as a member of staff.
- Written personal invitations from an exhibiting company: are no longer valid as proof of trade visitor status for vouchers or e-codes. Written personal invitation from an exhibiting company: <u>NEW in 2018</u>: Only valid in combination with chargeable tickets. Written personal invitations from an exhibiting company are no longer valid as proof of trade visitor status for vouchers or e-codes!
- Admission vouchers are <u>not</u> valid as proof of trade visitor status! Stated documents (<u>except</u> invitation from an exhibiting company) must be provided as proof of trade visitor status.

Note: Business cards are not acceptable as proof of trade visitor status!
